

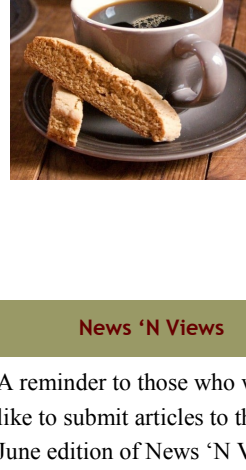


Updates and Reminders

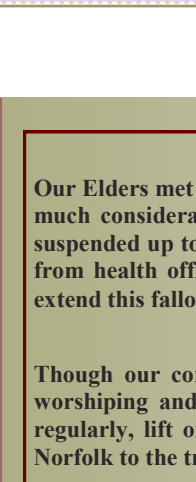
