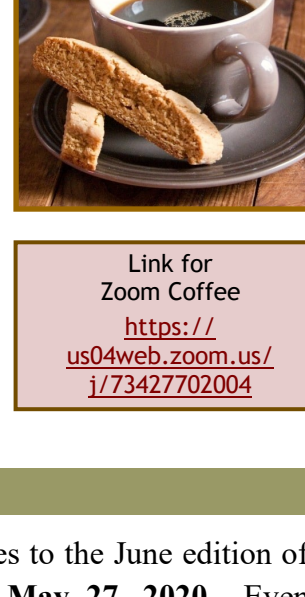
### On-line Worship Service and Coffee Hour

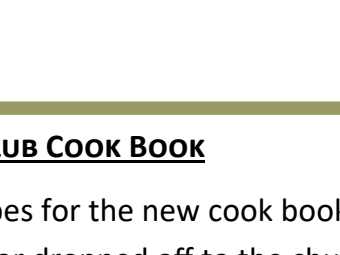
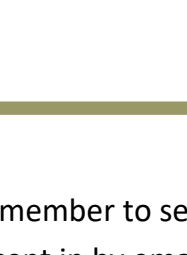

*"It is with great sadness that we are announcing that the 2020 on-site summer programs at Camp Kintail have been canceled. This decision was not made lightly, but with prayer, research, and consultation by the Kintail staff and Camp Board. The health, safety, and well-being of every camper, staff, volunteer, and guest is our highest priority. Without widespread testing or a vaccine for COVID-19, it is simply not safe to offer on-site programs to children and youth this summer."*
