INNES MATHER MISSION



In mid-October St. Paul's provided the 1000th food card to a local resident.

The food cards are part of the Innes Mather fund mission and are also supported by donations from the congregation. Currently, the food cards given out are for \$25 rather than \$10 as grocery prices are rising. As a result, fewer cards are available to be given out (down from 10/month to only 6/month). Lunch bags are now being made available to those who come to the door but have missed out on a food card. The lunch bags contain non-perishable items such as canned soups or pasta, crackers, fruit cups and other similar nutritious items that are easy to both store and transport. Blessing bags (small bags with travel sized personal care items) are also available to those in need. Currently, the Blessing Bag program needs donation of feminine products. Thank you for your continued support of these local mission initiatives.

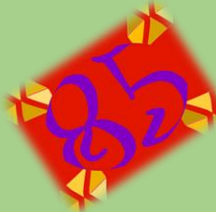
