**THANKSGIVING FOOD DRIVE: SUNDAY, OCTOBER 10, 2021**

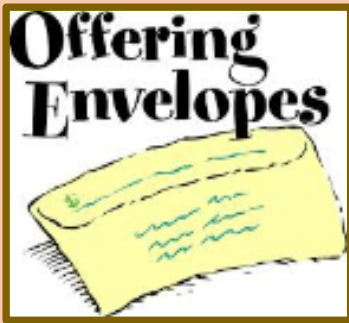
Please help us continue the tradition of decorating our church with non-perishable foods.
